Shopping

What else is there to do?

Bermuda Maritime Museum:

Containing exhibits of Bermuda's rich nautical history

Dolphin Quest: A 30-minute swim with Atlantic bottlenose dolphins.

Gladys Morrell Nature Reserve:

Perfect for nomadic strolls above Mangrove Bay featuring lovely foliage and nesting areas for endangered Bermuda bluebirds.

Skyrider Parasailing: It's easy to take off for a chair parasail ride built for two from the rear of a Para-Nautique powerboat. So easy, it's even safe enough for kids.

Somerset Village:

A postcard-pretty village that might look familiar. It was featured in the 1962 film, "A Touch of Mink," with Cary Grant and Doris Day.

What else is there to do?

Snorkel Park: The best attraction is the Seascooter Safari. For all ages and swimming abilities, it's an electric scooter ride on the water. You can also rent gear and snorkel the well marked trails.

Golf

Transportation

Kings Wharf is the gateway to your visit to Bermuda. You can see and navigate the entire island by using the convenient and easy transportation system. Within a few feet from the cruise docks, you can catch either the ferry, bus or nearby taxi cabs. It is recommended that you purchase the combination bus/ferry pass which will take you all over the island for just \$12.00 per day.

Travel Time

The ferry trip from Kings Wharf to Hamilton or Kings Wharf to Saint Georges is approximately 20-30 minutes of absolute breathtaking beauty. It is recommended that you take the ferry from Kings Wharf to either Hamilton or Saint Georges and then the bus within each of those destinations.

What is the weather like?

Bermuda enjoys a mild subtropical climate. Temperatures range from the low 80's to upper 80's (Fahrenheit) from June through October. November – March temperature drops and ranges from the 70's – mid 50's, but never freezes.

Language and Currency

English is spoken throughout Bermuda and the currency is the Bermudian Dollar, which is equivalent to a US\$. US Currency is readily accepted anywhere on the island
